



2021 New-Race* Grant Application
Application Deadline: Day of Race

Purpose

The Colorado Cycling budgets a certain amount annually to support clubs and/or race directors that take the financial risk of putting on an event at a new venue. Frequently, the first year of a new event comes with increased costs and the potential for insufficient racer support while the new event becomes established.

Application Procedure

The Colorado Cycling Board of Directors (BOD) will accept applications beginning January 1st of a given year and going through the day the race begins. There is no other application or selection criteria. Just fill out the minimal information on the part at the bottom and submit to operations@coloradocycling.org

Nature of the 2021 New Race Grant

New races will be reimbursed a % of the officials' fees based on the list below. These are fees and overtime, and do not include mileage, per diem, or other expenses of the officials. The amounts may be modified in a case where there are more new races than foreseen. The budget for this line item in 2021 is \$3000.

Road Races and Stage Races – 100% of the officials' fees

Criterion and Hillclimbs – 50% of the officials' fees

Time Trials and Cyclocross – 25% of the officials' fees

Awarding of the Grants

Grant money will be subtracted from the surcharges due for the race or, in a case where the surcharges are not greater than the grant, issued to the club or race director in the form of a check after the surcharges are subtracted.

* *To qualify as a new race, the venue must either have never been used before, or the race is being promoted by a new club or independent race director after the race has been off the schedule for two years.*
