



**2021 State Championship Support Race Grant Application**  
**Application Deadline: Day of Race**

**Purpose**

The Colorado Cycling budgets a certain amount annually to support clubs and/or race directors that undertake the much needed task of hosting a State Championship. Frequently, hosting a State Championship carries some financial and logistical burdens, and Colorado Cycling wishes to reward those clubs and race directors that provide this service to Colorado riders.

**Application Procedure**

The Colorado Cycling (BOD) will accept applications beginning January 1<sup>st</sup> of a given year and going through the day the race begins. There is no other application or selection criteria. Just fill out the minimal information on the part at the bottom and submit to [operations@coloradocycling.org](mailto:operations@coloradocycling.org)

**Nature of the 2021 State Championship Support Grant**

State Championships will be reimbursed a % of the officials' fees based on the list below. These are fees and overtime, and do not include mileage, per diem, or other expenses of the officials. The amounts may be modified in a case where unforeseen circumstances would cause this to go significantly over the annual budget. The budget for this line item in 2021 is \$3500.

State Championship for one class (i.e Senior, Junior, or Master) – 25% of officials' fees

State Championship for two classes – 50% of the officials' fees.

State Championship for all three classes – 75% of the officials' fees

**Awarding of the Grants**

Grant money will be subtracted from the surcharges due for the race or, in a case where the surcharges are not greater than the grant, issued to the club or race director in the form of a check after the surcharges are subtracted.
